



Have you had problems because you could not prove your legal right to live in the UK?

You could be eligible for compensation.

[Compensation is available to people of all ages and nationalities including those from African, Asian and Caribbean backgrounds.](#)

What can I claim for?

You can claim for problems such as:

Losing access to benefits, housing and free healthcare

Losing your job

Missing out on education, or being denied banking or a driving license

Being unable to travel

Facing problems with border officials

Being detained or deported

Wider non-financial impacts such as anxiety or distress

Who can claim?

You may be able to claim if:

- you or your parents came to the UK from any Commonwealth country before 1973
- you came to the UK from any country before the end of 1988

Some grandchildren and close family members may also be able to claim compensation.
